These transportation projects are built or underway in the Byrom area.



Boones Ferry Rd at Tualatin High School – *Built!*

A mid-block crosswalk was installed near Tualatin High School's south entrance. During the school year, this is a very busy crossing point for students and their families. The project includes pedestrian-activated flashing beacons and sidewalks constructed to fill gaps. The goal is to improve access for students walking or biking to school.



A strong construction season with good weather led to completion of pedestrian and bicycle safety improvements at Tualatin High School.

Boones Ferry Corridor Sidewalk and Bike Lane Project – Create continuous facilities along Boones Ferry Rd for safer walking and biking. Complete missing segments between Norwood Rd and Warm Springs St.
