

# Here's What's Happening in Your Neighborhood

December 2020

Six transportation projects are built or underway in the Commercial area.

## Tualatin-Sherwood Rd: Martinazzi Ave to I-5






This key project tackles Tualatin's busiest intersection: the junction of Tualatin-Sherwood Rd and I-5, near Fred Meyer. Computer modeling led to a design that reduces commute time and saves money. Instead of reconfiguring the intersection, the project will restripe the existing lanes and adjust the signage, while extending the third eastbound lane to the east. This will better balance traffic across all lanes. The time savings experienced by every resident and business between Boones Ferry and I-5 will be:



Reconfiguring the Tualatin-Sherwood Rd interchange begins in 2021

**Morning rush hour** ✓ **Reduced** from 6.5 minutes to 4 minutes  
**Afternoon rush hour** ✓ **Reduced** from 8 minutes to 6 minutes

### The Other Projects

-  **Mohawk St: East of Martinazzi Ave at PGE – Built!** Upgraded the mid-block crosswalk on Tualatin Rd to make a better connection with Community Park.
-  **90th Ave near Kaiser Permanente – Built!** Improve pedestrian safety and access across 90<sup>th</sup> Ave at Kaiser Permanente. Installation of high-visibility crosswalks, pedestrian-activated flashing beacons, and curb ramps to enhance ADA accessibility.
-  **118th Ave and Herman Rd** – Upgrade the intersection to add a northbound turn lane.
-  **Tualatin Rd and Teton Ave** – Add a traffic signal at this intersection.
-  **Boones Ferry Rd at Tualatin Commons – New!** Install a pedestrian-activated flashing beacon at existing crosswalk in the commercial core.
