Six transportation projects are built or underway in the East Tualatin area.



Borland Rd: Bridgeport Elementary School to 60th Ave – Built!

This project provides a new crosswalk to help kids safely cross Borland Rd to access Bridgeport Elementary School and Atfalati Park. The project includes installation of a high-visibility crosswalk on Borland Rd, along with pedestrian-activated flashing beacons, and curb ramps to improve ADA accessibility.

A new crosswalk and other pedestrian safety improvements on Borland Rd serve students at Bridgeport Elementary School.



More Projects



Sagert St at Atfalati Park – Built! Installed a pedestrian-activated flashing beacon and crosswalk. Replaced deteriorating sidewalk segments.



65th Ave near Meridian Park Hospital – Add a new mid-block crosswalk to connect the sidewalk on the west side of 65th Ave with the hospital on the east side.



Nyberg Ln and 57th Ave – New! Enhance existing crosswalks; install driver feedback signs.



Sagert St and 72nd Ave – New! Install new pedestrian-activated flashing beacon at existing crosswalk.



50th Ave and Wilke Rd – New! Driver speed control and signage, with new crosswalk.
