Four transportation projects are built or underway in the Martinazzi Woods area.



Martinazzi Ave and Sagert St

This project relieves congestion at one of Tualatin's busiest and most complicated intersections. A new traffic signal will replace the current 4-way stop.

Planned features will also improve safety for pedestrians and bicyclists:

- ✓ New sidewalks
- ✓ Pedestrian crosswalks
- ✓ Bike lanes



Construction of improvements at the busy Martinazzi/Sagert intersection is planned to begin in 2021.

The Other Projects



Martinazzi Ave: between Avery St and Dakota Dr – Built! Installation of two driver feedback signs to slow traffic on Martinazzi Ave.



Avery St: Boones Ferry Rd to Martinazzi Ave – Built! Installation of driver feedback signs to slow traffic on Avery St.



Boones Ferry Rd and Arapaho Rd – New! Install a new pedestrian-activated flashing beacon at an existing crosswalk.

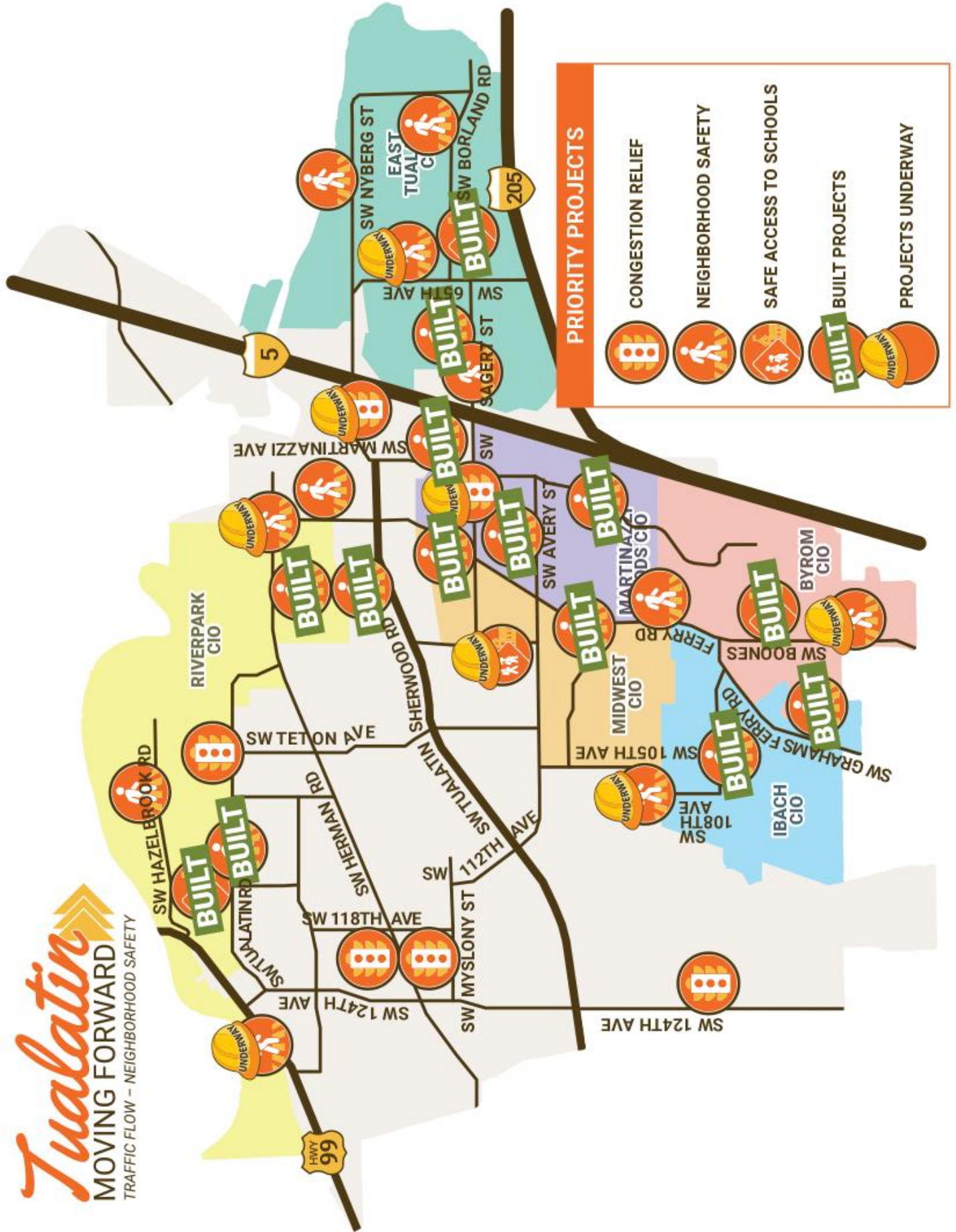
Suggest a Project
