Nasoma Ln: Near Marquis Assisted Living – Built! Installation of a midblock crossing on Nasoma Ln with a high-visibility crosswalk, pedestrian-activated flashing beacon, and curb ramps for increased accessibility.



95th Ave and Avery St (Tualatin Elementary School) – Pedestrian safety and traffic control improvements near Tualatin Elementary School, along 95th and 93rd Avenues and Avery and Sagert Streets.
