

## Here's What's Happening in Your Neighborhood

December 2020

Six transportation projects are built or underway in the Riverpark area.



### 115<sup>th</sup> Ave: Tualatin Rd to Hazelbrook Rd – *Built!*

The road was restriped on 115<sup>th</sup> Ave to add buffered bike lanes. The new bike lanes serve Hazelbrook Middle School. No auto lanes or on-street parking spaces were removed.



115<sup>th</sup> Ave bike lanes were part of the first project completed for *Tualatin Moving Forward*.

### The Other Projects



*Tualatin Road: between 105th Ave and 115th Ave – Built!* This project includes installation of driver feedback signs, pedestrian-activated flashing beacons, a high-visibility crosswalk and ADA-compliant curb ramps to improve accessibility.



*90th Ave and Sweek Dr – Built!* Improves pedestrian safety and access across 90<sup>th</sup> Ave at Sweek Dr with installation of high-visibility crosswalks, pedestrian-activated flashing beacons and accessible curb ramps.



*Hwy 99W: Pony Ridge Neighborhood to 124th Ave.* New sidewalks along Hwy 99W to connect the Pony Ridge neighborhood with the signalized crossing at 124<sup>th</sup> Ave.



*Tualatin Rd: Sweek Dr to Community Park.* Add a pedestrian-activated flashing beacon to the existing midblock crosswalk. Sidewalk improvements will help provide safer pedestrian access to Community Park.



*Hazelbrook Rd at Jurgens Park – New!* Pedestrian-activated flashing beacon and new crosswalk at the entrance to the park.
