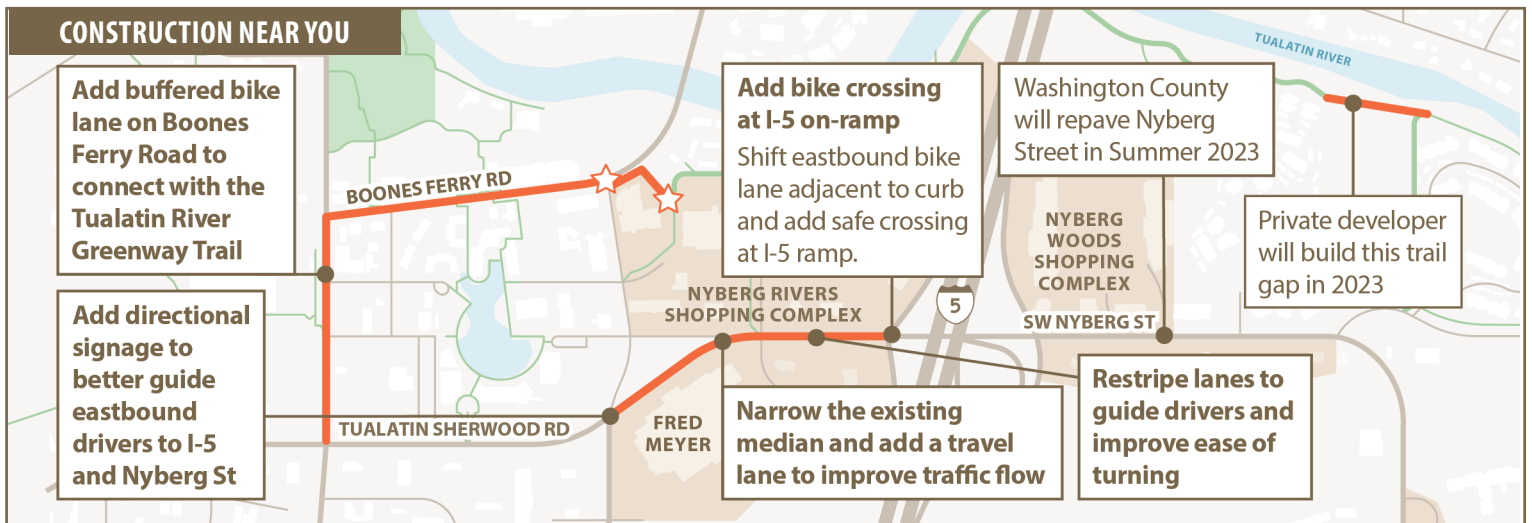


CONSTRUCTION WILL BEGIN SOON

ON THE TUALATIN-SHERWOOD RD: MARTINAZZI AVE TO I-5 PROJECT!

- Bike access

Construction will be completed by October.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- ⚠️ Tualatin-Sherwood Rd / Nyberg Road will remain open throughout construction.
- ⚠️ Flaggers will be used as needed – expect delays.
- ⚠️ Construction will occur at night.
- ⚠️ Some lane closures are planned between 9pm - 5am.
- ⚠️ Anticipate some noise during work hours from 9pm - 5am.
- ⚠️ A pedestrian detour map is provided on the project website.
- ⚠️ Some trees and shrubs will be removed along Tualatin-Sherwood Rd, but there will be plantings in their place.

WHY THESE PROJECTS?

The Tualatin Moving Forward program will make travel along Tualatin-Sherwood Rd/ Nyberg St between Martinazzi Ave and I-5 safer and more predictable, while also making it safer for people to walk and bike through the area. The City is making a series of small, strategic changes to the area that, together, will make it operate more smoothly. Changes include:

- Add a third eastbound lane from Martinazzi to I-5
- Repave and restripe lanes for more efficient allocation of traffic
- Install signage
- Improve bicycle access and safety throughout this corridor
